AMA was developed by the American Medical Association for the purpose of writing medical research. References are found at the end of a manuscript and are titled "Reference List," and each item should be listed in numerical order (two references should not be combined under a single reference number) as opposed to alphabetically.

AMA Manual of Style dictates that one must use endnotes with superscript arabic numerals outside periods and commas, but inside colons and semicolons. Example: The reference style followed by AMA journals is also based on recommendations of the NLM described in the National Library of Medicine Recommended Formats for Bibliographic Citation.1.1.

To cite a book in a reference entry in AMA style 10th edition include the following elements:. Author(s) of the book: Give the last name, and initials of up to six authors (e.g. Watson J). For more authors only the first three are listed, followed by et al. Title of the book: Italicize the title and capitalize the first letter of each major word. Edition number: Only include information about ...
